Rules of Conduct Camera Day

Movie Park Germany is not liable for the loss or damage of camera equipment or props.

On Camera Day, the following rules of conduct apply to all guests:

- Climbing on buildings, attractions or other scenery is prohibited!
- Restricted areas may only be entered upon request and in the presence of an employee.
- Entering scenery within an attraction is only possible in the presence of an employee.
- Droning shots are not permitted on Camera Day for operational reasons.
- It is not allowed to create obscene, offensive, radical, contemptuous or other image and video material that contradicts the image of Movie Park Germany.
- Movie Park Germany reserves the right to block published image and video material if it violates our guidelines.
- In addition to the above mentioned rules of conduct, the general park regulations apply.

For guests with a vehicle, the following additional rules of conduct apply:

- At the entrance you must hand in the signed disclaimer. You can download and print the disclaimer here: [Disclaimer](#)
- Vehicles of any kind may be moved only on the paved paths on the premises and may be placed off these paths only in the presence of a staff member.
- Walking speed applies on the entire premises.
- Be considerate of other vehicles and pedestrians.
- It is not allowed to drift, do donuts or perform other stunts on the premises!
- Rescue and escape routes must be kept clear at all times.

- Park your vehicles in a way that allows others to pass.
- Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited.
- Driving without a valid driver's license or in an unregistered vehicle without prior arrangement is prohibited.
- Any accident or damage to the vehicle or park property must be reported immediately to the staff.
- The backstage paths may only be used as thoroughfares for the vehicles; recordings are not allowed in these areas.
